Landvetter Airport in Gothenburg, Sweden



Bolon is being considered as the choice of flooring for a number of Swedavia's airports, starting with Gothenburg Landvetter Airport. Swedavia is a state-owned group that owns and operates airports across Sweden, with a focus on the travelling customer and sustainable development. Airports have extremely punishing environments that are subjected to constant wear and tear. A section in a high-traffic area was chosen as a test surface to enable the customer to monitor the floor over a period of time. This resulted in a carefully considered order for the purchase and installation of 1,000 m² of flooring from Bolon for Gothenburg Landvetter Airport. Shortly thereafter, 660 m² of floor tiles were installed at Stockholm Arlanda Airport. Malmö Airport is next in line to receive a makeover.
